## 1) Bring Them Home for the Holidays


Adopt and give a pet a cozy couch before the holidays.

#### 5) Your Adoption Fees—What They Fund

Wondering what your adoption fee supports? Here's a breakdown:

- Food & daily care: Quality meals, clean bedding, enrichment toys
- Safe housing: Sanitation, utilities, and upkeep
- Medical attention: Exams, diagnostics, medications, spay/neuter
- Vaccinations: Core vaccines to prevent illness
- Microchipping: Lifetime ID so lost pets can be reunited
- Behavior support: Training plans and post-adoption coaching
- Marketing & outreach: Photos, bios, events, and family matchmaking

Adoption fees don't "buy" a pet—they invest in their care and help us say "yes" to the next animal in need.

## Fund the Journey: \$25,000

We're seeking \$25,000 annually to fund the full journey—intake, daily care, medical, behavior, foster, marketing, and post-adoption support—for a cohort of PAWS animals so they're truly ready for forever homes.

## What \$25,000 accomplishes

- Funds the complete path to adoption for our most extreme animals (mix of easy and higherneeds cases).
- Keeps our "Once a PAWS animal, always a PAWS animal" promise with post-adoption coaching and safety-net "bounce-backs."

## **Critical Impact**

- Medical & preventives (vaccines, exams, meds, microchips, routine procedures)
- Daily care & nutrition (food, litter, cleaning, supplies). IDs/tech/misc (tags, data, printing)
- Behavior & training (readiness plans, staff time, consults, adopter coaching)
- Enrichment (toys, puzzles, scent/music, stress reduction)
- Marketing & adoption events (photos, bios, outreach, meet-and-greets)

## Why this level matters

- It creates predictable capacity: staff can plan training blocks, fosters, and events around a funded cohort.
- It fills the unglamorous but critical gaps (behavior time, quality photos, foster kits) that directly shorten length of stay.
