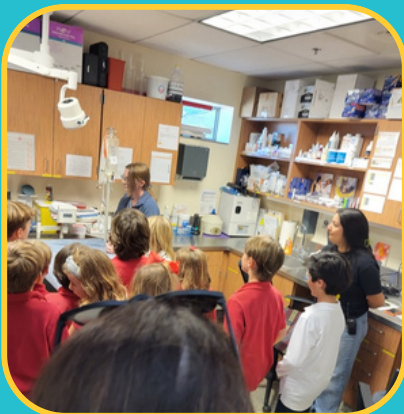

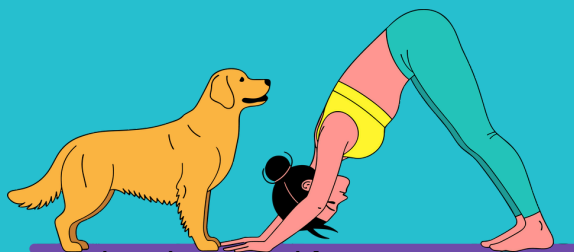


📧 A Heartfelt Thank You to Our Volunteers
